Thank you

Now Mr Kohu-Morris, you have an application

Your Honour, we appear to seek a 12-month extension to the date of the restraining order, which expires on 30 July

Thank you. Is there any objection from Counsel

No objections Your Honour

Thank you Miss Karl

No objections Your Honour

Thank you Mr Dennis-McCarthy

There being no objection, I grant the application and extend the restraining order to 31 July 2022
